APR 1-5



Very Heavy

Easter Sunday is April 5. Easter week was in the top 3 busiest weeks each year 2023-2025.

APR 6-12



Heavy

Post-Easter spring break stragglers. Buzz Lightyear reopens April 8, adding MK demand.

APR 13-19



Moderate

The transition week. Weekdays are comfortable. runDisney Springtime Surprise adds resort pressure, not park crowds.

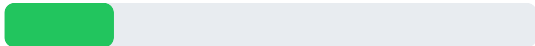
APR 20-26



Light

Post Spring Break bliss. Low crowds, and start of the pre-summer lull.

APR 27-30



Light

Late April and early May feature light crowds.

APRIL PLANNING TIPS

- **EPCOT Flower & Garden Festival**
EPCOT is in full bloom, running all month.
- **Extended Evening Hours**
Mondays at EPCOT, Wednesdays at MK. Avoid these parks on those days unless you have Deluxe Resort access.
- **Buzz Lightyear Reopening April 8**
The refreshed ride has new blasters, ride vehicles, and upgraded gameplay. Official reopening is April 8, but it has soft opened early.
- **Coaster Closures**
Rock N Roller Coaster and Big Thunder Mountain remain closed all month.
- **Refreshed Food Options**
Sci Fi Dine In Theater (DHS) features new menu items. Garden View Tea Room is officially reopened at Grand Floridian.
